The Minnesota Municipal Commission received a petition for the detachment of land from the Village of Donnelly, Minnesota on the 7th day of March, 1969, by the landowners. A resolution for the detachment of the same land was filed by the Village of Donnelly on the 7th day of March, 1969.

The territory involved consists of the following:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and Lot 3, County Subdivision of N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, Township 126 North, Range 43 West, containing 281.90 acres, more or less, and Lot One (1), County Subdivision of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, Township 126 North, Range 43 West, containing 13.50 acres more or less.

The property is adjacent to the Village of Donnelly and said lands are unplatted and used exclusively for agricultural purposes. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minnesota Statutes 414.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the Village of Donnelly, and

made a part of the Township of Donnelly, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
