The Minnesota Municipal Commission received a petition by the land-owners for the detachment of land from the Village of Bird Island, Minnesota, on the 7th day of December, 1971. A resolution for the detachment of the same land was filed by the Village of Bird Island on February 15, 1972.

The territory involved consists of the following:

The Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Twenty-three (23), Township One Hundred Fifteen (115), North, Range Thirty-four (34) West, Renville County, Minnesota, lying south of Renville County Ditch #66, the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$), of said Section Twenty-three (23), and the West Half of the Southeast Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twenty-three (23).

The property is adjacent to the Village of Bird Island and said lands are unplatted and used primarily for agricultural purposes. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minn. Stat. 414.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the Village of Bird Island and made a part of the Township of Bird Island, Renville County, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
