Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 412.091, the undersigned petitioners hereby petition the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustments to call a special election on the question of dissolving the City of Tenney, MN, and state as follows:

1. 3 voters voted in the last city election.
2. All persons signing this petition are voters duly qualified to vote in the city election for the City of Tenney, and 1 voters have signed this petition representing one third of the voters voting at the last preceding city election as required by Minnesota Statutes § 412.091.
3. The property abuts Campbell Township in Wilkin County to the (north, south, east, west, etc.) or is surrounded by Campbell Township.
4. The number of acres in this property proposed for dissolution is 21.89 acres.
5. The territory proposed to be dissolved consists of the area lying within the boundaries of the City of Tenney, Minnesota, located in of Sections 28, Township 130, Range 46 & includes City of Tenney's City Dump, located in of Sections 26, Township 130, Range 46 (which is 3 acres more or less of the total 21.89 acres proposed for dissolution).
6. The dissolution is requested because the majority of the voters feel that there is no longer a need for the City to exist because the population of the city has dwindled considerably over the years to now 5 people and city council can no longer govern legally as an incorporated city with only one mayor, one clerk/treasurer, and one council person and these three people are the only eligible voters residing in the city as well as the fact that there is no prospect for the city to increase its population.
7. The undersigned believe the City of Tenney will become a part of Campbell Township within Wilkin County.







