Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 412.091 and Minnesota Statutes 414.09, as amended, before the Chief Administrative Law Judge, in the above-entitled matter.

The hearing will convene at 1:30 p.m. on the 5th day of April, 2011, at the Old Methodist Church, 330 Concord Avenue, Tenney, Minnesota (the north entrance on the corner of Concord Avenue and Merimack Street). All persons shall be given an opportunity to be heard orally and to submit written data, statements or arguments concerning the above-entitled matter. Any person wishing to do so at that time should appear at the Old Methodist Church. The right to testify and the admission of testimony and other evidence shall be governed by the Rules of the Minnesota Municipal Board and any other Statutes or rules that may be applicable.

The area proposed to be dissolved is the City of Tenney, Minnesota, located in Section 28, Township 130, Range 46 & includes City of Tenney's City Dump, located in Sections 26, Township 130, Range 46.


After all testimony is complete and the record is closed, the Chief Administrative Law Judge will issue findings and an order in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 412.091 and Chapter 414. Any other person, group of persons, or governmental agency residing in, owning property in, or exercising jurisdiction over the subject area that submits a timely request, and is

determined by the presiding judge to have a direct legal interest that will be affected by the outcome of this proceeding may become a party. A party bears a portion of the hearing costs.
