County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of said Government Lot 12; thence westerly along the south line of said Government Lot 12 a distance of 750 feet, more or less, to the east line of the amended order in the matter of the orderly annexation agreement between the City of Cannon Falls and the Town of Cannon Falls pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414 dated December 4, 1998; thence northerly along said east line of the amended order 1311.67 feet, more or less, to the north line of said Government Lot 12; thence easterly along said north line of Government Lot 12 a distance of 750 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of said Government Lot 12; thence southerly along said east line of Government Lot 12 a distance of 1310.04 feet to the point of beginning.
