RESOLUTION NO. 341, SECOND SERIES

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING UNINCORPORATED AREAS AS IN NEED  
OF ORDERLY ANNEXATION AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION OVER  
SAID AREAS TO THE MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Certain properties within the Township of Fairview are in need of orderly annexation to the City of Marshall; and

WHEREAS, The properties are located in the County of Lyon and State of Minnesota and described as follows, to-wit:

That portion of the Southwest Quarter of Section 33, Township 112 North, Range 41 West and the Southeast quarter of Section 33, Township 112 North, Range 41 West as described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of North Seventh Street and the North Right of Way line of the Redwood River Diversion Channel; thence Westerly along the Redwood River Diversion Channel Right of Way to the Easterly Right of Way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad; thence Northeasterly along the Burlington Northern Railroad Right of Way to the East west quarter line of Section 33; thence Easterly along the quarter line of said Section 33 to the intersection of the center line of North Seventh Street; thence Southwesterly along the center line of North Seventh Street to the point of beginning containing 31.4 acres, more or less.


WHEREAS, Said properties are within the orderly annexation area agreement contained in Resolution No. 340, Second Series, dated November 5, 1979, between Fairview Township and the City of Marshall; and on file with the Minnesota Municipal Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That upon the adoption of this resolution by the Common Council of the City of Marshall, jurisdiction over annexation of the above described areas be conferred to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, pursuant to M.S.A. 414.032.
