RESOLUTION NO. 1301

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING AN UNINCORPORATED AREA AS IN NEED OF ORDERLY ANNEXATION AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION OVER SAID AREA TO THE MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, Certain property within the Township of Lake Marshall is in need of orderly annexation to the City of Marshall and,

WHEREAS, The property is located in the County of Lyon and State of Minnesota and described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Southerly 1,545 feet of the Westerly 1,349.15 feet of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 111N, R41W, Lyon County, Minnesota; lying Northerly of the center line of State Highway No. 19 and lying Easterly of the Easterly right-of-way line of State Highway No. 23; except the following parcel of land located therein and described as follows: Beginning at a point 1,180 feet North of the center of Trunk Highway No. 19 and on the East right-of-way line of Trunk Highway No. 23; thence East 370 feet; thence Southeast 230 feet; thence Southwest 395 feet; thence West 310 feet; thence North 440 feet to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, Said property is within the orderly annexation area agreement contained in Resolution No. 1283, dated March 4, 1974, among Lake Marshall Township, Fairview Township, and the City of Marshall; and on file with the Minnesota Municipal Commission,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That upon the adoption of this Resolution by the Common Council of the City of Marshall, jurisdiction over annexation of the above-described area be conferred to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, pursuant to M.S.A. 414.032.
