CITY OF BELLE PLAINE RESOLUTION NO. 17-029

JOINT RESOLUTION FOR THE ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY PURSUANT TO ORDERLY ANNEXATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Belle Plaine ("City") and Town of Belle Plaine ("Town") have agreed upon annexation of certain lands pursuant to Town Resolution No. 41204 and City Resolution No. 04-052, as amended by Town Resolution No. 140708 and City Resolution No. 14-071 (together, the "Orderly Annexation Agreement");

WHEREAS, the Orderly Annexation Agreement was established under Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.0325, Subd. 1;

WHEREAS, the Orderly Annexation Agreement sets forth all conditions for annexation of the lands described therein, and provides that the chief judge of the Office of Administrative Hearings, Municipal Boundary Adjustments ("OAH") may review and comment but shall, within thirty (30) days, order annexations requested pursuant to the Agreement;

WHEREAS, the City and Town have received an annexation request from the owner of certain property in the Town comprising 10.02 acres legally described on attached Exhibit A ("Property");

WHEREAS, the Property is within the lands covered by the Orderly Annexation Agreement;

WHEREAS, the owner has paid, or will pay, the taxation reimbursement amount due under the Orderly Annexation Agreement prior to submission of this Joint Resolution to the OAH;

WHEREAS, all other conditions set forth in the Orderly Annexation Agreement have been met including specifically adjustment of the "MUSA line" to include the Property, and the owner's submission of a development plan for the Property and associated subdivision request(s).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City and the Town:

1. <u>OAH Approval of Annexation</u>. The Orderly Annexation Agreement confers jurisdiction over annexation of the Property to the OAH. The OAH may review and comment but no additional consideration is necessary and annexation of the Property shall be ordered within thirty (30) days without alteration of the boundaries as required by law and provided in the Orderly Annexation Agreement.

2. <u>Development.</u> All development of the Property shall be conducted in accordance with the Orderly Annexation Agreement.

3. <u>Effective Date.</u> The order for annexation shall be effective upon issuance.






Belle Plaine Muni Boundary


