

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL
COMMISSION TO ANNEX A PORTION OF ST. CLOUD
TOWNSHIP TO THE CITY OF ST. CLOUD

WHEREAS, the City of St. Cloud and St. Cloud Township have signed a joint resolution for orderly annexation of part of St. Cloud Township, as per the photocopy attached hereto, and

WHEREAS, two of the property owners in the area designated in need of orderly annexation, to-wit: St. Cloud Opportunity, Inc., and Burlington Northern Railroad, Inc. have petitioned for annexation to the City of St. Cloud of a portion of their property, as per the attached photocopy of said petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CLOUD, MINNESOTA:

That the following described lands be annexed to the City of St. Cloud, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.032, Subd. 1:

Parcel A

That part of Section 8, T 124N, R 28W, described as follows: The entire Burlington Northern Right-of-Way from the west line of said Section 8 to the thread of the Sauk River, there connecting to the existing St. Cloud corporate limits at the point where the thread of the Sauk River intersects with the Burlington Northern's northerly right-of-way line, containing 1.10 acres, more or less.

Parcel B

That part of Section 7, T 124N, R 28W, described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of said Section 7; thence N 89°38'24" west along the south line of said Section 7, a distance of 2383.53 feet; thence N 0°00' east to a point on the northerly right-of-way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad line; thence easterly along said right-of-way line to the east line of said Section 7, thence S 0°00' west along the east line of said Section 7 to the point of beginning, containing 72.36 acres, more or less.
