

RESOLUTION

Alderman Stauss, supported by Alderman Mongoven, introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, The Township of Rhinehart and the City of East Grand Forks, both of the County of Polk and State of Minnesota, have entered into a Joint Resolution as to Orderly Annexation, as to a part of said Township of Rhinehart; and

WHEREAS, In said Joint Resolution, the Township of Rhinehart agrees not to object to annexation during the next year of the remaining portions of Section 12 in said Township, not presently a part of the City of East Grand Forks, except for one parcel therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the City Council of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, being one of the parties to said Joint Resolution, that the City of East Grand Forks respectfully requests that the Minnesota Municipal Commission take such steps, and conducts said Hearings as are necessary, (pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.032) to annex the following described lands, to the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, to-wit:

All those tracts and parcels of land in Section Twelve (12), Township 151 North, Range 50 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, not currently a part of the City of East Grand Forks, nor within its corporate boundaries, except for the following tract of land, to-wit:

That part of the East half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$), which lies Southwest of the highway (except for Robertson and Woodland Additions), and the South five (5) acres of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (S 5 acres of the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$), (except for .53 acres), all being in Section 12, Township 151-50.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk-Treasurer forward a copy of this Resolution to the Minnesota Municipal Commission.
