

RESOLUTION REQUESTING MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL
BOARD TO ORDER HEARING AND ANNEXATION

6/22/79

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo and the Town of Buffalo have designated an unincorporated area in Buffalo Township as in need of orderly annexation by the City of Buffalo and conferred jurisdiction for annexation in such area to the Minnesota Municipal Board by submitting a joint resolution to the secretary thereof, such resolution being adopted on June 24, 1974, by the City of Buffalo and filed with the Minnesota Municipal Board on July 17, 1974, and designated OA-108 Buffalo, City and Town, by such Board; and

WHEREAS, the area designated to be in need of orderly annexation during the period June 24, 1974, through June 24, 1979 (to which annexation the Town of Buffalo will not object during such period) in Minnesota Municipal Board Order OA-108 Buffalo, City and Town, includes that certain tract of land located in the Town of Buffalo hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, that certain tract of land located in the Town of Buffalo, County of Wright, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of the North one-half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 19, Township 120, Range 25, which lies South and West of the Northeast right of way line of Minn. T.H. No. 55.

Lot A of the Northwest Quarter South of the Northeast line of Minn. T. H. No. 55 except tract conveyed to Helen C. Hoffman by deed in the Register of Deeds Office of said County in Book 163 of Deeds, page 409, all in Section 19, Township 120, Range 25

That part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, Township 120, Range 25, lying within the right of way lines of Minn. Trunk Highway No. 55 and the Soo Line Railroad

is now or is about to become urban or suburban in nature, and the City of Buffalo is capable of providing the services required by the above described area within a reasonable time; and

WHEREAS, certain owners of part of the above described tract have petitioned the City of Buffalo to have the same annexed by the City of Buffalo; and

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo is a signatory to the joint resolution above referred to;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Buffalo, Wright County, Minnesota, hereby requests the Minnesota Municipal Board to set a time and place for hearing in accordance with Minnesota Statute 414.09 and to order the annexation of the above described premises by the City of Buffalo in accordance with Minnesota Statute 414.0325.
