WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Dilworth and the Town of Moorhead; and

WHEREAS, a resolution was received from the City of Dilworth indicating their desire that certain property be annexed to the City of Dilworth pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2005, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Dilworth, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) and all of the South 58.24' of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section 1, Township 139 North, Range 48 West, located in the County

of Clay and State of Minnesota. Said part contains 162 acres, more or less, and subject to highway rights-of-way and easements of record.
