

JOINT RESOLUTION BY MADISON CITY
COUNCIL AND MADISON TOWN BOARD TO
INITIATE ORDERLY ANNEXATION OF
DESIGNATED AREAS TO THE CITY OF
MADISON

WHEREAS, the City of Madison and the Town of Madison desire to designate certain areas hereafter described abutting on the corporate limits of the City of Madison and lying in the Town of Madison, as in need of orderly annexation to the City of Madison, and

WHEREAS, such areas have become or may in the near future become urban in nature and are or may be served by city utilities and services, and

WHEREAS, certain street improvement projects for these designated areas have been recommended by the City of Madison Planning Commission, and

WHEREAS, the annexation of these areas will be in the best interests of the City of Madison and the Town of Madison.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That certain areas of land lying in the Town of Madison, County of Lac qui Parle, State of Minnesota, be designated as in need of orderly annexation and hereby confer upon the Secretary of the Minnesota Municipal Commissioner jurisdiction over annexation of the following described parcels of real estate situated in the County of Lac qui Parle, State of Minnesota, to-wit:

The South two hundred feet of Lots Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14) and Fifteen (15), Kjosness Addition to the City of Madison,

and

Lots Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9) and Eleven (11), Evergreen Addition to the City of Madison,

according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Lac qui Parle County, Minnesota.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Minnesota Municipal Commission be requested to approve annexation of the following described parcels within the designated area hereinbefore described as presently in need of annexation, to-wit:

The South two hundred feet of Lots Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), and Fifteen (15), Kjosness Addition to the City of Madison,

and

Lots Six (6) and Nine (9), Evergreen Addition to the City of Madison,

according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Lac qui Parle County, Minnesota.

The above mentioned resolutions were submitted to the Madison City Council at a meeting held on October 6, 1975, at which meeting councilman Bissett moved their adoption, said motion being seconded by councilman Zahrbock. Upon put to a vote the resolutions were unanimously passed.
