IN THE MATTER OF THE ORDERLY ANNEXATION)
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WATERTOWN) ORDER
AND THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN PURSUANT TO)
MINNESOTA STATUTES 414)

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Watertown and the Town of Watertown; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the joint resolution was received from the City of Watertown and the Town of Watertown requesting that certain property be annexed to the City of Watertown pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subdivision 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Minnesota Municipal Board may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 1997, the Minnesota Municipal Board has reviewed and accepted the amendment to the joint resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Watertown, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

Commencing at the Northeasterly corner of Outlot One Hundred Fourteen (114) at the intersection of Angel and High Street; thence southwesterly along the easterly line of Outlot 114 distance of 132 feet; thence

Northwesterly parallel to the northeasterly line of Outlots 103 and 114 for a distance of 330 feet; thence Northeasterly parallel to the westerly line of Outlot 103 to the Northwesterly corner of Outlot 103; thence Southeasterly along northeasterly line of Outlots 103 and 114 to the place of beginning; being the Northeasterly 132 feet of Outlots 103 and 114 Town or Village of Watertown, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Carver County, Minnesota.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the population of the City of Watertown is increased by 1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the population of the Town of Watertown is decreased by 1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is April 4, 1997.
