WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Cleveland and the Town of Cleveland; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Cleveland pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge.

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2005, the Chief Administrative Law Judge reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Cleveland, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

Part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 110 North, Range 25 West, Le Sueur County, Minnesota lying 66.00 feet South of the following described line: Beginning at the intersection of the East right of way line of

C.S.A.H. No. 15 with the South line of Block 61, CITY OF CLEVELAND, according to the recorded plat thereof; thence South 89 degrees 11 minutes 57 seconds East (assumed bearing), along the South line of Blocks 61 and 60, a distance of 589.63 feet to the Southeast Corner of said Block 60 and there terminating. The sidelines of said parcel shall be prolonged or shortened to terminate at the said East right of way line of C.S.A.H. No. 15 and the Southerly extension of the East line of said Block 60.
