IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Holdingford, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

The Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE ¼ SE ¼) of Section 17, Township 126, Range 30, Stearns County, Minnesota AND

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW ¼ SE ¼) of Section Seventeen (17), Township One Hundred Twenty-six (126) North, Range

Thirty (30) West, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said NW ¼ SE ¼; thence Westerly along the North line thereof a distance of 233.00 feet, more or less, to the centerline of the South Branch of Two Rivers; thence Southeasterly along said centerline a distance of 853 feet, more or less, to the East line of said NW ¼ SE ¼; thence Northerly along said East line a distance of 756.00 feet, more or less to the point of beginning.
