WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2005, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Chisago City, Minnesota, the

same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

That part of the East 300 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¼ of NE¼), Section Thirty-one (31), Township Thirty-four (34) North, Range Twenty (20) West, Chisago County, Minnesota, lying southerly of the northerly right of way line of County State Aid Highway No. 19, and subject to County State Aid Highway No. 19 along the northerly line. Subject to easements and reservations of record.
