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ORDER

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of St. Cloud and the Town of Sauk Rapids; and

WHEREAS, said resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of St. Cloud pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2005, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of St. Cloud, Minnesota, the same

as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

That part of the SE ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 25, Township 36, Range 31, Benton County, Minnesota lying south of the Great Northern Railroad right-of-way and lying northerly of the centerline of East St. Germain (old T.H. No. 23) and lying easterly of the centerline of Benton County No. 1, subject to said road right-of-ways.
