WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of
Rochester and the Town of Cascade; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the joint resolution was received from the City of
Rochester and the Town of Cascade requesting that certain property be annexed to the City of
Rochester pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic
and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the
annexation pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2004, the Director has reviewed and accepted the resolution
for orderly annexation;


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in
accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Rochester, Minnesota, the same
as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

The westerly 155.00 feet of the southerly 372.30 feet of the northerly 422.30 feet of the

Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 107, Range 14, Olmsted County. Containing 1.32 acres more or less. And also, any and all right of way for 19th Street N.W., that is adjacent to the above-described property and that has not previously been annexed to the City of Rochester.
