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IN THE MATTER OF THE ORDERLY ANNEXATION )  
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONTGOMERY )  
AND THE TOWN OF MONTGOMERY PURSUANT TO ) ORDER  
MINNESOTA STATUTES 414 )  
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WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of  
Montgomery and the Town of Montgomery; and

WHEREAS, said resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of  
Montgomery pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic  
and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the  
annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the  
duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2006, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and  
accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in  
accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Montgomery, Minnesota, the

same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:


Commencing 1677 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 9, in Township 111 North, of Range 23 West, in LeSueur County, Minnesota, thence running South 63 feet, thence West 50 feet, thence South 120 feet, thence East 125 feet, thence North 183 feet, thence West 75 feet to the place, being in the Northeast Quarter of Sec. 9-111-23, West, in LeSueur County, Minnesota. Said tract being a part of Lot 6 of Auditor's Subdivision of a part of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 9.

And Also

A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 111, Range 23, described as follows: Commencing at a point 1602 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 9, Township 111, Range 23 West, thence South 183 feet, thence East 75 feet, thence North 183 feet, thence West 75 feet to point of beginning.
