IN THE MATTER OF THE ORDERLY ANNEXATION )  
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ELROSA )  
AND THE TOWN OF LAKE GEORGE PURSUANT ) ORDER  
TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414 )

---

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Elrosa and the Town of Lake George; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Elrosa pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2006, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Elrosa, Minnesota, the same

as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE1/4 NE1/4) of Section 9, Township 124N, Range 34, described as follows: Beginning on the northerly line of the railway right of way described in deed dated August 5, 1908, which is recorded in Book 131 of Deeds, page 120; at a point which is 200 feet Southwesterly of the point of intersection of said line by the East line of said Section 9; thence due West and parallel with the North line of said Section, 240 feet; thence due South and parallel with the said East line 175 feet more or less, to the Northerly line of the said right of way and thence Northeasterly with the said Northerly line to the place of beginning.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036, the Town of Lake George will be reimbursed by the City of Elrosa in accordance with the terms of Joint Resolution No. 2006-2 signed by the City of Elrosa and the Town of Lake George on March 28, 2006.
