A RESOLUTION OF ALBERT LEA TOWNSHIP AND THE CITY OF ALBERT LEA DESIGNATING AN UNINCORPORATED AREA AS IN NEED OF ORDERLY ANNEXATION AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION OVER SAID AREA TO THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS OFFICE OF THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS PURSUANT TO M.S.414.0325 - EDGEWATER BAY BOAT LANDING -

WHEREAS, this property is owned by the Minnesota Department of Transportation and the city is negotiating a Limited Use Permit for a public water access over this land, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources and the City of Albert Lea are drafting an agreement to coordinate this project within the City of Albert Lea, and

WHEREAS the City of Albert Lea is requesting annexation of property in the SE1/4 NW1/4 Section 6-T102N-R21W consisting of approximately 13.02 acres; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Albert Lea and the City of Albert Lea hereby jointly agree to the following; now, therefore

THE CITY OF ALBERT LEA RESOLVES:

Sec. 1. That the following described area in Albert Lea Township is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly annexation:

All that part of the SE¼ NW¼ Section 6-T102N-R21W, Freeborn County, Minnesota; described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 1, Imperial Addition, as the same is platted and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Freeborn County, Minnesota;

thence North 44°46'14" West a distance of 794.07 feet, on the westerly right-of-way line of Trunk Highway No. 13, to the easterly right-of-way line of the Union Pacific Railroad (formerly the Chicago & North Western Transportation Company);

thence North 25°45'24" West a distance of 110.00 feet, on the easterly right-of-way line of said Union Pacific Railroad, to a point on the north line of the SE14 NW14 of said Section 6;

thence North 89°42'42" East a distance of 1133 feet more or less, on the north line of said SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, to the northeast corner thereof;

thence South 00°27'53" East a distance of 661 feet more or less, on the east line of said SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, to the point of intersection with an easterly extension of the north line of said Lot 1, Block 1, Imperial Addition;

thence South 89°13'53" West a distance of 530 feet more or less, on said easterly extension of the north line of Lot 1, Block 1, Imperial Addition, to the point of beginning.

Containing 13.02 acres more or less.

Sec. 4. That the City agrees to investigate the possibility of sharing facilities, equipment, and personnel with the township to forestall the duplication of facilities and to reduce the overall costs of government in the area.

Sec. 5. That no population is affected by this annexation.

Sec. 6. That no alteration of the area is appropriate, that this resolution provides for annexation of a designated area, and no consideration by the Municipal Boundary Adjustments Office of the Office of Administrative Hearings is necessary, no alteration of the agreed upon boundaries is appropriate, all conditions for annexation have been stated in this resolution and the Municipal Boundary Adjustments Office of the Office of Administrative Hearings may review and comment, but shall, within 30 days of receipt of the joint resolution, order the annexation.

Sec. 7. That planning throughout the orderly annexation area shall be pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325. Planning and zoning for the area shall be provided by the City of Albert Lea.

Sec. 8. That any person owning lands annexed to the City pursuant to this agreement shall have all rights provided by statute and Resolution 06-89 of the City of Albert Lea governing special assessments. That the customary hookup charges approved for property in the City shall be used for connection to City utilities.

Sec. 9. That the City of Albert Lea and the Township of Albert Lea agrees that no money is due for taxes as this is public land and currently exempt from taxes.

Sec. 10. That a joint informational meeting was held by the City Council of the City of Albert Lea and by the Supervisors of the Township of Albert Lea on April 9, 2007.

Sec. 11. That reading of this resolution is waived by Council consent.
