IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to

the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

All of Government Lots 1, 2, 3, & 7 and the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ and the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ in Section 22, Township 139 N Range 41 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Becker County,

AND

Additional Right of Way of North Tower Road located in Section 15, Township 139 N Range 41 W of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Becker County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036, the Town of Detroit will be reimbursed by the City of Detroit Lakes in accordance with the terms of the Joint Resolution signed by the City of Detroit Lakes on May 8, 2007 and the Town of Detroit on May 8, 2007.
