That the following described area in New London Township is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly annexation:

Lot 1 and Lot 2 of Block 2 of Cedar Crescent - Containing .513 acres, more or less.

That the Township of New London does, upon passage of this resolution and its adoption by the City Council of the City of New London, Minnesota, and upon acceptance by the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustments, confer jurisdiction upon the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustments over the various provisions contained in this agreement. No consideration by upon the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustments is necessary, upon the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustments review and comment, but shall, within 30 days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of the resolution.

Certain properties are presently residential in nature or are about to become so. Further, the City of New London is capable of providing services to this area within a reasonable time.
