WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of New Ulm and the Town of Milford and duly accepted by the Minnesota Municipal Board; and

WHEREAS, a resolution was received from the City of New Ulm indicating their desire that certain property be annexed to the City of New Ulm pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subdivision 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Minnesota Municipal Board may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 1992, the Minnesota Municipal Board has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of New Ulm, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

A. Property description: Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot "B" of the East Half of the West Half, Section Thirty (30), Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Thirty (30) West, Brown County, Minnesota, which is 1,581.55 feet North OO Degrees, 4 Minutes West of the Center of said Section 30, this being the point of beginning; then North OO Degrees, 4 Minutes West along the half section line, a

distance of 1,047.55 feet; thence South 89 Degrees, 56 Minutes West a distance of 343.46 feet; thence South 00 Degrees 4 Minutes East a distance of 1,047.55 feet; thence North 89 Degrees, 56 Minutes East a distance of 343.46 feet to the point of beginning, containing eight acres, more or less.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is April 2, 1992.
