IN THE MATTER OF THE ORDERLY ANNEXATION)
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MAZEPPA)
AND MAZEPPA TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO) ORDER
MINNESOTA STATUTES 414)

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of
Mazeppa and Mazeppa Township; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the
City of Mazeppa pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Chief Administrative
Law Judge may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation pursuant to
said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2008, the Chief Administrative Law Judge reviewed and
accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in
accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Mazeppa, Minnesota, the same as
if it had originally been made a part thereof:

- County of Wabasha, State of Minnesota: The West 279 feet of Auditor’s Lot Eight (8) in the
Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 7, Township 109, Range 14.
- County of Wabasha, State of Minnesota: Lot Seven (7), being the East 9½ rods of the North
13 rods of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼NW¼) of Section 7,
Township 109 North, Range 14 West.

County of Wabasha, State of Minnesota: The East 352 feet of Auditor's Lot Eight (8) in the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 7, Township 109, Range 14.

All that part of Town Road 1 (formerly Wabasha County Road 11) lying adjacent to, and south of, the above described lands, to the southerly right of way of the said Town Road 1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036, Mazeppa Township will be reimbursed by the City of Mazeppa in accordance with the terms of the Joint Resolution signed by the city and the township on February 6, 2008; and the Joint Resolution signed by the city and township on April 7, 2008.
