IN THE MATTER OF THE ORDERLY ANNEXATION)
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORWOOD) FINDINGS OF FACT
YOUNG AMERICA AND YOUNG AMERICA TOWNSHIP) CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414) AND ORDER

The joint resolution for orderly annexation submitted by the City of Norwood Young America and Young America Township was reviewed for conformity with applicable law. By delegation, the Chief Administrative Law Judge's designee hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. A joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Norwood Young America and Young America Township pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 414.0325 and duly filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustments.
2. A joint resolution adopted and submitted by the City of Norwood Young America and Young America Township requests annexation of part of the designated area described as follows:

Lot 6, Block 1, Oakridge, Carver County, Minnesota
3. Minnesota Statutes §414.0325, subd. 1(h) states that in certain circumstances the Chief Administrative Law Judge may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation pursuant to the terms of a joint resolution for orderly annexation.
4. The joint resolution contains all the information required by Minnesota Statutes

§414.0325, subd. 1(h), including a provision that the Chief Administrative Law Judge may review and comment but shall order the annexation within 30 days in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Office of Administrative Hearings has duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.
2. An order should be issued by the Chief Administrative Law Judge annexing the area described herein.

ORDER

1. The property described in Findings of Fact 2 is annexed to the City of Norwood Young America, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
2. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §414.036, Young America Township will be reimbursed by the City of Norwood Young America in accordance with the terms of Joint Resolution No. 2008-24 signed by the City on February 25, 2008 and the Township on March 19, 2008; and the Joint Resolution signed by the City on November 22, 2010 and the Township on November 9, 2010.
