AMENDMENT TO JOINT RESOLUTION FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION (OA-143) (Town of Wells Resolution 2004 - <u>최ዕ</u>) (City of Faribault Resolution 2004 -070)

The Town of Wells and the City of Faribault hereby jointly agree to the following:

- 1. The following described area in the Town of Wells is not included in the original orderly annexation agreement, shall be included in this amendment as area for annexation:
 - The Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 13, T110N-R21W, Rice County, Minnesota.
- 2. The property to be annexed shall be zoned TUD, Transitional Urban Development, as provided by Ordinance 2004-13.
- 3. The Town Board of the Town of Wells and the City Council of the City of Faribault, upon passage and adoption of this resolution and upon acceptance by the Minnesota Municipal Boundary Adjustments, confer jurisdiction upon the Minnesota Municipal Boundary Adjustments over the various provisions contained in the agreement.
- 4. This certain property, which abuts the City of Faribault, is presently urban or suburban in nature or about to become so. In addition, the City of Faribault is capable of providing services to this area within a reasonable time, and the annexation is in the best interest of the area proposed for annexation. Therefore, the property as described above would be immediately annexed to the City of Faribault.
- Both the Town of Wells and the City of Faribault agree that no alteration of the states boundaries of this agreement is appropriate. Furthermore, each party agrees that no consideration by the Minnesota Municipal Boundary Adjustments is necessary. Upon receipt of this resolution, passed and adopted by each party, the Minnesota Municipal Boundary Adjustments may review and comment, but shall, within thirty (30) days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of this joint resolution.




