RESOLUTION FOR ANNEXATION
OF AREA DESIGNATED FOR
ORDERLY ANNEXATION

WHEREAS the City of Jackson and the Township of Des Moines did in 1984 designate the following area in need of orderly annexation and did, by Joint Resolution and by Areement with the owners of land within the area designated provide that this property should be annexed into the City of Jackson in December of 1988:

That portion of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter $(E_2^{1}NW_4^{1})$ of Section 23, Township 102 North, Range 35 West, lying South of the South shore line of the Des Moines River and North of the North line of Springfield Parkway (a/k/a Jackson County Highway #14) in Jackson County, Minnesota.

Therefore the Municipal Board may review and comment, but shall order the annexation within 30 days in accordance with the terms of the Joint Resolution.

That portion of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter $(E_2^{1}NW_4^{2})$ of Section 23, Township 102 North, Range 35 West, lying South of the South shore line of the Des Moines River and North of the North line of Springfield Parkway (a/k/a Jackson County Highway #14) in Jackson County, Minnesota.
