AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF AUSTIN) ORDER
AND THE TOWN OF AUSTIN PURSUANT TO)
MINNESOTA STATUTES 414)

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Austin and the Town of Austin and duly accepted by the Minnesota Municipal Board; and

WHEREAS, a resolution was received from the City of Austin indicating their desire that certain property be annexed to the City of Austin pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subdivision 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Minnesota Municipal Board may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on October 13, 1988, the Minnesota Municipal Board has reviewed and approved the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Austin, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:


Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 11, Block 2, Oak Ridge Addition, Mower County, Minnesota, thence westerly along the north line of said Block 2 extended to the west property line of 23rd Street S.W. which is also the east line of Block 1 of said Oak Ridge Addition thence southerly along the west property line of 23rd Street

S.W. to the south property line of 9th Avenue S.W. thence easterly along the south property line of 9th Avenue S.W. until it intersects the east line of said Lot 11, Block 2, extended southerly thence northerly on this extension to the northeast corner of said Lot 11 and the point of beginning. 1.5 acres.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is October 13, 1988.
