In the Matter of the Orderly Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Big Lake from Big Lake Township (MBAU Docket OA-1649-1)

ORDER AMENDING THE ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION

On July 7, 2016, an Order Approving Annexation was issued for the annexation of certain real property (Property) pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.0325 (2016).

On July 13, 2016, the City of Big Lake (City) submitted a request for an amendment of the legal description in the July 7, 2016 Order Approving Annexation to more accurately describe the Property.

Based upon a review of the proceeding, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. The legal description in the July 7, 2016 Order Approving Annexation is **amended** to read as follows:

The North 1509.65 feet of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 33, Range 28, Sherburne County, Minnesota lying East of a line drawn from a point on the North line of said West Half of the Southwest Quarter distant 862.58 feet West of the Northeast corner of said West Half of the Southwest Quarter to a point on the South line of said West Half of the Southwest Quarter distant 873.18 feet West of the Southeast corner of said West Half of the Southwest Quarter.

EXCEPT

That part of the North 1509.65 feet of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 33, Range 28, Sherburne County, Minnesota which lies westerly of the West line of the East 768.30 feet, as measured at a right angle from the East line thereof, of said West Half of the Southwest Quarter and which lies easterly of a line drawn from a point on the North line of said West Half of the Southwest Quarter distant 862.58 feet West of the Northeast corner of said West Half of the Southwest Quarter to a point on the South

line of said West Half of the Southwest Quarter distant 873.18 feet West of the Southeast corner of said West Half of the Southwest Quarter.
