RESOLUTION NO. 2000-13

A RESOLUTION ANNEXING THE LAND KNOWN AS THE OLD ST. CLOUD WINDOW PROPERTY

WHEREAS, a request was received for the annexation of part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 36 North, Range 31 West, Benton County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on February 28, 2000 at which time all persons desiring to be heard were given an opportunity, and

WHEREAS, the Sauk Rapids Joint Planning Board and the Sauk Rapids Planning Commission have reviewed and recommended the annexation, and

WHEREAS, the City Council, the Township Board and the property owners all agree to the annexation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SAUK RAPIDS CITY COUNCIL THAT:

1. The following described property is hereby annexed:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW1/4 NW1/4) of Section 25, Township 36 North, Range 31 West, Benton County, Minnesota described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of said Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter; thence westerly along the south line of said Southwest Quarter, Northwest Quarter a distance of 150.00 feet; thence northerly and parallel to the east line of said Southwest Quarter, Northwest Quarter to its intersection with the centerline of 5th Street South, formerly Benton County Road #46; thence southeasterly along said centerline to its intersection with said east line of Southwest Quarter, Northwest Quarter, thence southerly along said east line to the point of beginning, less part previously annexed.]

AND

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE1/4, NW1/4) of Section 25, Township 36 North, Range 31 West, Benton County, Minnesota, lying West of Minnesota State Highway #10 and South of 5th Street South, formerly Benton County Road #46, less part previously annexed.

2. That the quantity of land described above is approximately 3.83 acres.

3. In accord with MSA414.0325 and the existing Orderly Annexation Agreement between the City of Sauk Rapids and Sauk Rapids Township, the Minnesota Municipal Boundary Adjustments is asked to approve the annexation.
