AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION  
OVER SAID AREA TO THE  
MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL BOARD  
PURSUANT TO M. S. 414.0325

JOINT RESOLUTION  
FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION

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The Township of Chisago Lake and the City of Chisago City and the  
City of Lindstrom hereby jointly agree to the following:

1. That the following described area in Chisago Lake Township  
is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes  
414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly  
annexation, to-wit:

The South 330 feet of that part of Government Lot Six (6),  
Section Thirty Two (32), Township Thirty Four (34), Range  
Twenty (20), lying west of State Trunk Highway No. 8, as  
the same is now located across said Government Lot 6,  
excepting therefrom the railroad right-of-way, if any.

AND

That part of the north 330 feet of the South Half of that  
part of Government lot Six (6), Section Thirty-Two (32),  
Township Thirty-four (34), Range Twenty (20) which lies  
west of the State Trunk Highway No. 8 as now located  
across said lot, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the west right-of-way line of  
the Northern Pacific Railroad as now located across  
said Lot 6, a distance of 332 feet North and 1801.1 feet  
east of the southwest corner of said Section 32; thence  
due west and parallel with the south line of said Section  
32, a distance of 200 feet; thence due north a distance  
of 300 feet; thence due east, a distance of 283 feet,  
more or less, to the west right-of-way line of the  
Northern Pacific Railroad; thence southwesterly along the  
said west right-of-way line, a distance of 311 feet, more  
or less, to the place of beginning.

2. That the Town Board of the Township of Chisago Lake and the City Council of the City of Chisago City and the City Council of City of Lindstrom, upon passage and the adoption of this resolution and upon the acceptance by the Municipal Board, confirm jurisdiction upon the Municipal Board over the various provisions contained in the agreement.

3. That these certain properties which abut the City of Chisago City are urban or suburban in nature or are about to become so. Further, the City of Chisago is capable of providing services to this area, and the annexation is in the best interests of the area proposed for annexation. Therefore, these properties would be immediately annexed to the City of Chisago City, to-wit:

The South 330 feet of that part of Government Lot Six (6), Section Thirty Two (32), Township Thirty Four (34), Range Twenty (20), lying west of State Trunk Highway No. 8, as the same is now located across said Government Lot 6, excepting therefrom the railroad right-of-way, if any.

AND

That part of the north 330 feet of the South Half of that part of Government lot Six (6), Section Thirty-Two (32), Township Thirty-four (34), Range Twenty (20) which lies west of the State Trunk Highway No. 8 as now located across said lot, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the west right-of-way line of the Northern Pacific Railroad as now located across said Lot 6, a distance of 332 feet North and 1801.1 feet east of the southwest corner of said Section 32; thence due west and parallel with the south line of said Section 32, a distance of 200 feet; thence due north a distance of 300 feet; thence due east, a distance of 283 feet, more or less, to the west right-of-way line of the Northern Pacific Railroad; thence southwesterly along the said west right-of-way line, a distance of 311 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning.

4. The Town of Chisago Lake, the City of Chisago City and the City of Lindstrom agree that no alteration of the stated boundaries of this agreement is appropriate. Furthermore, each party agrees that no consideration by the Municipal Board is necessary. Upon receipt of this resolution, passed and adopted by each party, the Municipal board may review and comment, but shall, within thirty (30) day, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of this joint resolution.
