**ORDER APPROVING
ANNEXATION**

Southside Township Resolution No. 2021-04/City of Annandale Resolution No. 2021-45 (Joint Resolution) was adopted by the City of Annandale (City) on October 4, 2021, and Southside Township (Township) on September 7, 2021, requesting the designation and immediate annexation of certain real property (Property) legally described as follows:


The S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$; Government Lot 2 and that part of Government Lot 1 described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Lot 1; thence West 2 rods on the South line of Lot 1; thence Northeasterly across Lot 1 to a point on the East line of said Lot 1 that is 2 rods North of the Southeast corner of said Lot 1; thence South along the East line 2 rods to the point of beginning, all in Section 25, Township 121, Range 28, Wright County, Minnesota.

Based upon a review of the Joint Resolution, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.0325 (2020), the Joint Resolution is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Joint Resolution and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to the agreement of the parties and as allowed by Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2020), the City shall reimburse the Township as stated in the Joint Resolution.
