IN THE MATTER OF THE JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LINDSTROM, AND THE TOWN OF CHISAGO LAKE DESIGNATING AN UNINCORPORATED AREA AS IN NEED OF ORDERLY ANNEXATION AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION OVER SAID AREA TO THE MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL BOARD PURSUANT TO M.S. 414.0325

JOINT RESOLUTION FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION

The Town of Chisago Lake and the City of Lindstrom hereby jointly agree to the following: That the following described area in Chisago Lake Township is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for immediate orderly annexation, to-wit: That part of Government Lot 2, Section 4, Township 33 North, Range 20 West, Chisago County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the centerline of Olinda Trail (also know as State Aid Highway No. 25) and the intersection with 292nd Street, bearing southerly along said centerline a distance more or less of 105 feet, thence easterly a distance more or less of 665 feet to the shoreline of South Center Lake, thence northeasterly along said shoreline to the northeast corner of Lot 7 of Gabrielson Parcels Addition, thence northwesterly to the west side of recorded street easement line of Morningside Court, thence southwesterly along said line to the the center line of Olinda Trail, thence southerly to the point of beginning.

2. That the Town Board of the Township of Chisago Lake and the City Council of the City of Lindstrom, upon passage and the adoption of this Joint Resolution and upon the acceptance by the Municipal Board, confirm jurisdiction upon the Municipal Board over the various provisions contained in this Joint Resolution.

3. That the designated annexation area abutting the City of Lindstrom is urban or suburban in nature or are about to become so. Furthermore, the City of Lindstrom is capable of providing services to this area, and hence the annexation is in the best interests of the area proposed for annexation.

4. The Town of Chisago Lake and the City of Lindstrom agree that no alteration of the stated boundaries of this agreement is appropriate. Furthermore, each party agrees that no consideration by the Municipal Board is necessary. Upon receipt of this resolution, passed and adopted by each party, the Municipal Board may review and comment, and shall, within thirty (30) days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of this Joint Resolution.
