## JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING ANNEXATION PORTIONS OF 19<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE NORTH & 2 ½ STREET NORTH RIGHTS OF WAY

The East 33.00 feet of the Northeast Quarter of Section 30;

The West 33.00 feet of the Northwest Quarter of Section 29;

The East 33.00 feet of the Southeast Quarter of Section 19;

The West 33.00 feet of the Southwest Quarter of Section 20;

The North 33.00 feet of the Southwest Quarter of Section 20;

The North 33.00 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 20, less and except that portion platted as CITY OF SARTELL RIGHT OF WAY PLAT NUMBER 1, according to the recorded plat thereof, on file and of record in the Office of the County Recorder, Stearns County, Minnesota. All of the above being in Township 125 North, Range 28 West, Stearns County, Minnesota and contains 11 acres, more or less.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** That said property is being annexed to the City of Sartell under zoning classification of R-1, Single Family Residence District, and has a current population of 0.
