IN THE MATTER OF THE ORDERLY ANNEXATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SARTELL AND THE TOWN OF LE SAUK PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414	•	ORDER	

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Sartell and the Town of Le Sauk; and

WHEREAS, a resolution was received from the City of Sartell indicating their desire that certain property be annexed to the City of Sartell pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subd. 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325, M.S. 414.11, and M.S. 414.12 states that in certain circumstances the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2001, the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the resolution to the City of Sartell, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

All of the existing right-of-way of Stearns County Road No. 119 that lies within

the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 29, the Southwest Quarter and the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 28, the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33 and the North Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, all in Township 125 North Range 28 West, Stearns County, Minnesota that lies between two lines run parallel with and 33 feet on each side of the centerline of Stearns County Road No. 119 described below, between the intersection of Pine Cone Road and Stearns County Road No. 119 to the intersection of Stearns County Road No. 119 and the westerly right-of-way line of Stearns County State Aid Highway No. 1, as measured along said centerline. The above described property contains 12 acres, more or less.
