WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2005, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Stillwater, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

That part of the East one-half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section

19, Township 30, Range 20 West, Washington County, which lies Southerly of the South right-of-way line of the former Burlington Northern Railroad right-of-way. Parcel ID No. 19-030-20-41-0003.
