annexation pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the

duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2007, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Stillwater, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

All of Lot 6, Block 2, Neal Meadows, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Washington County Recorder.

Stillwater will be reimbursed by the City of Stillwater in accordance with the terms of Joint

Resolution signed by the City of Stillwater and the Town of Stillwater on August 16, 1996.
