- 1. The North 1,000 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¹/₄ of NE ¹/₄) Section 13, Township 33, Range 28. Consisting of 30.3 acres more or less.
- 2. The North 1,000 feet of the Northwest Quarter of said Northwest Quarter (NW ¼ of NW ¼) Section 18, Township 33, Range 27. Consisting of 30.3 acres more or less.


