2. That the Town Board of the Township of Pierz, and the City Council of the City of Genola, upon passage and adoption of this Resolution and upon the acceptance by the Municipal Board, confer jurisdiction upon the Municipal Board over the various provisions contained in this Agreement.

3. That this certain property which is surrounded by the City of Genola is presently urban or suburban in nature or is about to become so. Further, the City of Genola is

capable of providing services to this area within a reasonable time, and the annexation is in the best interest of the area proposed for annexation.

5. Upon annexation, the City shall zone said property residential.

6. Both Pierz Township and the City of Genola agree that no alteration of the stated boundaries of this Agreement is appropriate. Furthermore, each party agrees that no consideration by the Municipal Board is necessary. Upon receipt of this Resolution, passed and adopted by each party, the Municipal Board may review and comment, but

shall, within thirty (30) days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of this joint Resolution.
