JOINT RESOLUTION FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION

(Ken Jude Property)

The Township of Maple Lake (the "Township") and the City of Maple Lake (the "City") hereby jointly resolve and agree as follows:

- 1. The property described on the attached Exhibit A (the "Property") is located in the Township, is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate the Property for orderly annexation.
- 2. The Township does, upon passage of this resolution and its adoption by the City, and upon acceptance by the Minnesota Municipal Board, confer jurisdiction upon the Minnesota Municipal Board over the various provisions contained in this Agreement.
- 3. The Property abuts or would abut the City but for the intervening County Road 8, and is presently suburban in nature. The City is capable of providing essential sewer and water services to the Property within a reasonable time, which the Township is not. Annexation would be in the best interests of the Property. The Property should be immediately annexed to the City.
- 4. Real estate taxes levied in 1997, payable in 1998, in the amount of \$ 5.71, shall be paid entirely to the Township. Real estate taxes for later years shall be divided. The following percentages of the real estate taxes levied in 1997, payable 1998, shall be paid to the Township:

- 5. Kenneth and Myrna Jude, as owners of the Property to be annexed to the City pursuant to this Agreement, shall have rights and obligations with regard to conditions of annexation and the payment of fees, costs, assessments and hook-up charges on projects previously completed by the City as set forth in a separate Annexation and Assessment Agreement to be entered into between Judes and the City.
- 6. No consideration by the Minnesota Municipal Board is necessary. The Board may review and comment but shall, within 30 days, order the annexation.


