JOINT RESOLUTION FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION

(City of Jeffers Resolution #99-101)

The Township of Amboy and the City of Jeffers hereby jointly agree to the following:

1. That the following described area in Amboy Township is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly annexation, to-wit:

PROPOSED ANNEXATION DESCRIPTION:

Part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 20, Township 107 North, Range 36 West in Amboy Township, Cottonwood County, Minnesota, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 20; thence North 00000'00" East, assumed bearing, along the West line of said Northeast Quarter and along the center line of County State Aid Highway No. 52, as exists, a distance of 392.00 feet; thence South 89024'00" East, parallel with the South line of said Northeast Quarter, a distance of 251.00 feet; thence South 00000'00" West, parallel with the West line of said Northeast Quarter, a distance of 143.00 feet; thence South 89024'00" East, parallel with the South line of said Northeast Quarter, a distance of 79.00 feet; thence South 00000'00" West, parallel with the West line of said Northeast Quarter, a distance of 249.00 feet, to a point on the South line of said Northeast Quarter; thence North 89024'00" West, along the South line of said Northeast Quarter, a distance of 330.00 feet, to the point of beginning.

The tract contains 2.71 acres and is subject to existing highway easement and other easements of record, if any.

2. That the Town Board of the Township of Amboy, and the City Council of the City of Jeffers, upon passage and adoption of this resolution and upon the acceptance by the Municipal Board, confer jurisdiction upon the Municipal Board over the various provisions contained in the Agreement.

- 3. That these certain properties which abut the City of Jeffers are presently urban or suburban in nature or are about to become so. Further, the City of Jeffers is capable of providing services to this area within a reasonable time, and the annexation is in the best interest of the area proposed for annexation. Therefore, these properties would be immediately annexed to the City of Jeffers, to-wit:
- That all of the land owners have joined on a petition to the City of Jeffers for annexation.
- 5. Both the Town of Amboy and the City of Jeffers agree that no alteration of the stated boundaries in this Agreement is appropriate. Furthermore, each party agrees that no consideration by the Municipal Board is necessary. Upon receipt of this resolution, passed and adopted by each party, the Municipal Board may review and comment, but shall within thirty (30) days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of this joint resolution.
