1. The following described property situated in the County of Steele, State of Minnesota, to wit:

The South Half of Fifth Avenue Southeast lying between the lines of the Union Pacific Railroad and the L& M Pail Link

shall be and hereby is annexed to the City of Medford.

- 2. The above-described property consists of 0.6 acres. A map showing the relationship of the above-described property to the municipal limits of the City of Medford is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 3. This Joint Resolution shall be filed with the Minnesota Municipal Board together with the appropriate filing fee.


