JOINT RESOLUTION 1999-20 FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION

IN THE MATTER OF THE JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF AUDUBON AND THE CITY OF AUDUBON DESIGNATING AN UNINCORPORATED AREA AS IN NEED OF ORDERLY ANNEXATION AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION OVER SAID AREA TO THE MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL BOARD PURSUANT TO M.S. 414.0235.

The township of Audubon and the City of Audubon hereby jointly agree to the following:

1. The following described area in Audubon Township is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statute 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly annexation:

The east boundary line of Section 16, Township 139 N, Range 42 W, starting where it intersects the north right of way line of State Trunk Highway 10, then northwesterly 810 feet, more or less to the corner of State of Minnesota right of way, then northeasterly 38 feet, more or less to the right of way of Becker county #51, then southeasterly 760 feet, more or less to the east line of Section 16 and south 110 feet, more or less to the point of beginning, for a total of 1.38 acres.

2. That no alteration of its stated boundaries is appropriate for this area in need of orderly annexation.
3. That the Township of Audubon, does upon passage of this resolution and its adoption by the City Council of the City of Audubon, Minnesota and upon acceptance by the Minnesota Municipal Board, confer jurisdiction upon the Minnesota Municipal Board over the various provisions contained in this Resolution.
4. Certain properties abutting the City of Audubon are presently urban or suburban in nature or are about to become so. Further, the City of Audubon is capable of providing services to this area within a reasonable time and the annexation would be in the best interests of the area proposed for annexation. Therefore, these properties would be immediately annexed to the City of Audubon.
5. That the City of Audubon agrees to investigate the possibility of sharing facilities and equipment with the Township to forestall the duplication of facilities and to reduce the overall costs of government in the area.

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6. That the effect of annexation on population shall be resolved whenever possible by agreement of parties. If there is failure to reach such agreement, the question shall be resolved by the Minnesota Municipal Board.
7. That planning through the orderly annexation area shall be pursuant to Minnesota Statute 415.0325.

The property abuts the City of Audubon and the proposed annexation includes only 810 x 38-foot area previously described.

8. Not consideration of the Municipal Board is necessary.

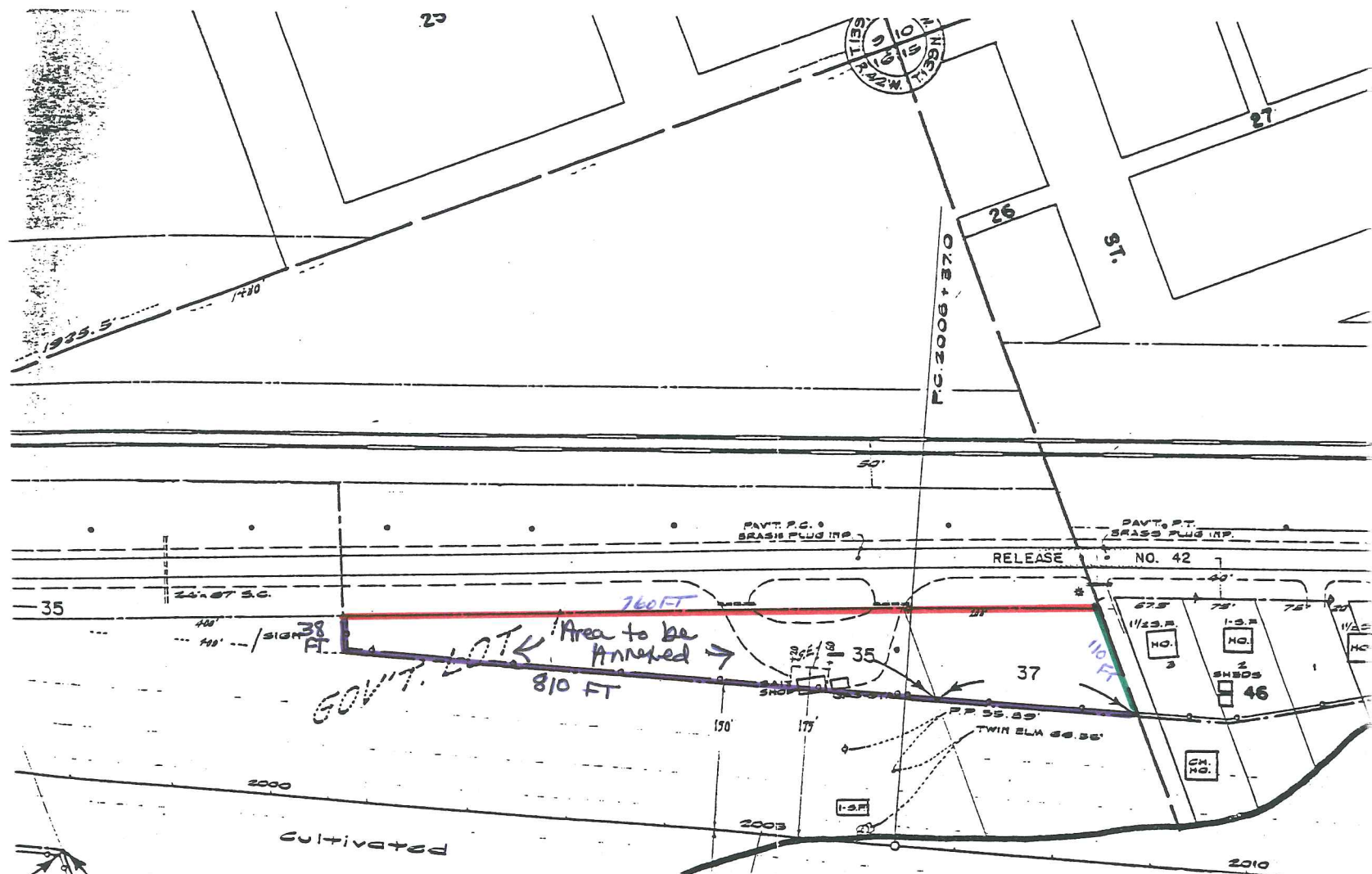

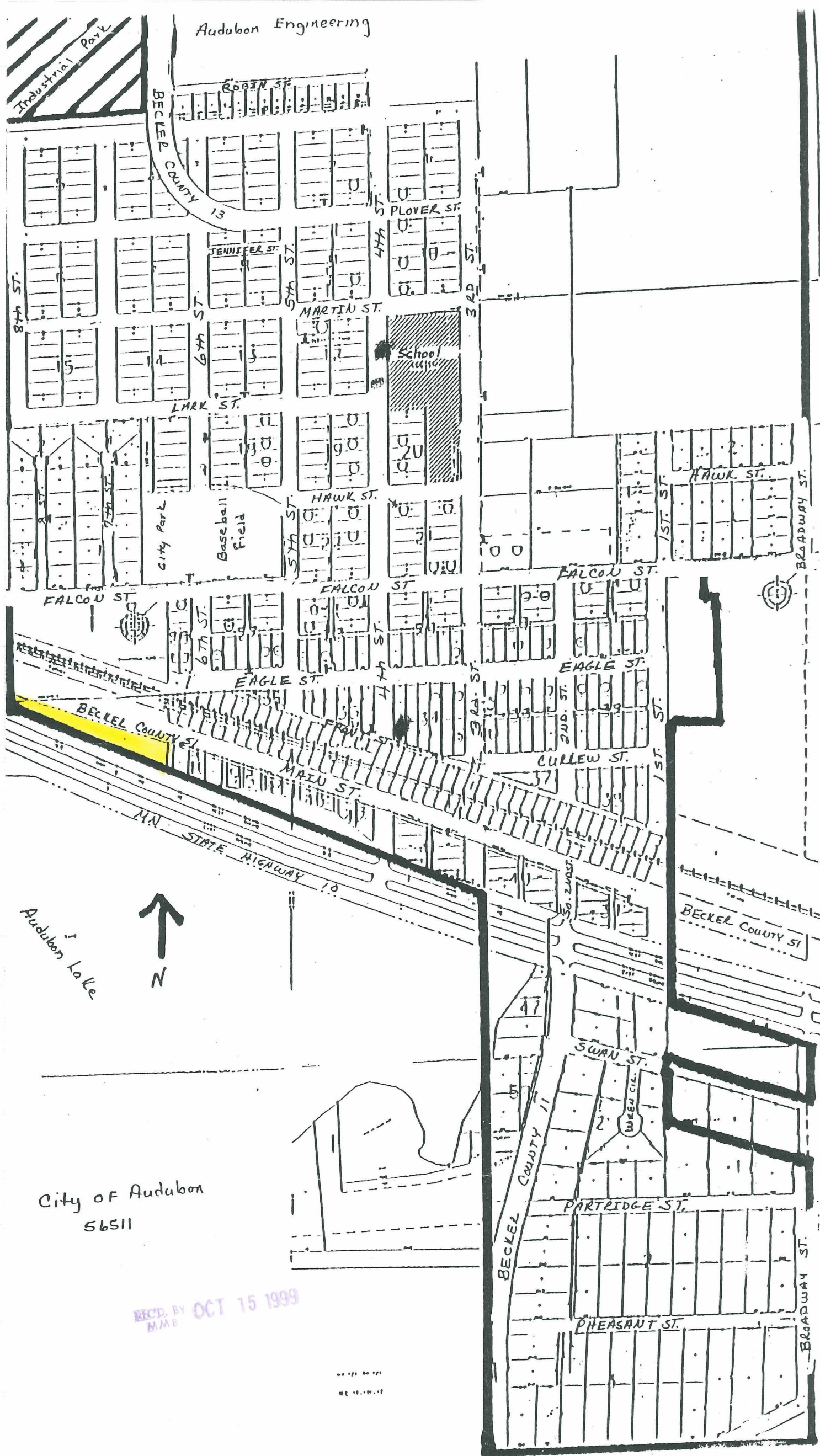
