ORDER

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WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Heron Lake and the Town of Weimer; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Heron Lake pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subd. 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325, M.S. 414.11, and M.S. 414.12 states that in certain circumstances the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2000, the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Heron Lake, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been

made a part thereof:

That part of the West One-Half of the Southwest Quarter (W1/2 SW1/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township One Hundred Four (104) North, Range Thirty-seven (37), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Jackson County, Minnesota, as follows: Commencing at a point 33 feet north and 20 feet East of the Northeast corner of Lot Eight (8) of Hanson's Third Addition, thence south along the East right-of-way of the 20 foot alley lying east of said Lot Eight (8) a distance of 413 feet, thence due East a distance of 211 feet, thence North parallel with the east right-of-way line of said alley East of Lot Eight (8) a distance of 413 feet, thence West a distance of 211 feet to the point of commencement, containing two acres.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is February 11, 2000.
