That the area described as the SE ¼ of the SW ¼ and the SW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 31, Township 125 North, Range 28 West, less and except that part of the SW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 31, in Township 125 North, of the Range 28 West, in Stearns County, Minnesota, which lies east of a line drawn north at an angle of 89 degrees 38 minutes and

28 seconds with the south line of said Section 31 (as measured from west to north) from a point thereon distant 1694.77 feet west of the SE corner of said Section 31 and depicted in Exhibit B is hereby approved for annexation to the City of St. Cloud.
