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WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Jackson and the Town of Des Moines; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Jackson pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subd. 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325, M.S. 414.11, and M.S. 414.12 states that in certain circumstances the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2002, the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Jackson, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

That part of the SW ¼ NE ¼ of Section 13 in Township 102, North of Range 35, West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of said Section 13, running thence South 01 degrees 20 minutes 40 seconds East, assumed bearing, 1,997.90 feet along the east section line to the centerline of CSAH 38, thence South 88 degrees 02 minutes 50 seconds West 2,010.96 feet along said centerline to the point of beginning: thence continuing South 88 degrees 02 minutes 50 seconds West along said centerline 665.97 feet to the quarter line; thence North 01 degrees 19 minutes 53 seconds West 675.00 feet along the quarter line to the south right-of-way line of Minnesota Interstate Hwy 90; thence North 88 degrees 02 minutes 50 seconds East 665.82 feet along said south right-of-way line; thence South 01 degrees 20 minutes 40 seconds East 675.00 feet to the point of beginning; and comprises approximately 10.32 acres, subject to existing highways, roadways, or easements.
